Fees:

Everyone by now should have received an email with a letter attached about the new fees coming in to effect from 8th April.

Activities for this half-term:

We have started this half term looking at colours, counting and patterns. We have made some great colour pictures and used our colour elephants to make colour patterns.

This half-term we have enjoyed learning about the festival of the Chinese New Year, this year is the year of the dragon. We have enjoyed lots of crafts including lucky pockets, lanterns, stories about China and the Chinese New Year and trying out Chinese dancing and Chinese food.

We have had a visit from Robot Reg and had lots of fun learning sounds and phonics through games, songs and music. We will be using some of the games we learnt with the children in our own phonic sessions. In the run up to the summer term we are looking at making more links with the local schools and teachers to make the transitions to school easier when it is your child's time to move to school.

At home:

While out and about why not talk to the children about what signs you see and the letters they might recognise. Encourage your children to spots familiar signs and letters.

Coughs and colds.

Just a polite reminder that if your child has a cough and/or cold and are well in themselves they are still able to attend preschool. If your child has a temperature or has had or requires Calpol, please keep them at home until their temperature has returned to normal and they no longer require Calpol.

If your child has a stomach bug can we please remind you that you need to keep your child at home for 48hours after the last episode.

Fundraising:

With the monies raised we plan to purchase new resources to build on our current resources, a new shed for the garden which we plan on adding a chalk board to the side so the children have lots more mark making opportunities outside. This will also give us enough staff to give the children more quality time with the children.
